TOPIC: *Impacts of the Folsom Lake Crossing on Traffic Volumes*

The Folsom Lake Crossing was completed in March 2009. The crossing reconnects a vital corridor between E. Natoma Street and Folsom-Auburn Road and provides a direct route from Folsom and El Dorado County to Placer County. The four-lane bridge is 1,000-feet long and sits 200 feet over the American River. Mark Rackovan will discuss the impacts the bridge has had on traffic volumes and circulation.
