Mobility Strategies for County Corridors

Mr. Jeff Clark, Senior Civil Engineer for Sacramento County Department of Transportation gave an overview of the Mobility Strategies for County Corridors at the May meeting. The study is a technical evaluation of the 11 most congested roadway corridors in Sacramento County. It will identify a multitude of possible transportation and land use strategies to manage congestion anticipated in the next 25 years. Strategies include transit services and facilities, widening of existing roadways, new roadways, bicycle and pedestrian facilities and changes in land use patterns. Mr. Clark presented an in-depth evaluation of Florin Road showing the issues and possible solutions to the issues identified. The same in-depth evaluation was done for each of the 11 corridors in the study.

At the meeting Carol Pearce from Caltrans was honored with the District Lifetime Achievement Award.
